

We strive to provide activities and opportunities to promote the development of readiness skills, self-expression, physical and social/emotional growth. Curriculum is developed following Pre-K standards set for preschoolers in cooperation with New Albany-Plain Local schools.



Our curriculum includes:

Language Arts...enhance & develop letters & reading.

Math & Science...discover the wonders of science & the process of math.

Social Studies...seasons, the community, transportation, holidays, animals etc.

Bible lessons...prayers, Bible stories & know God can be a part of our everyday lives.

Art...enhance fine motor skills, creative expression and crafts.

Music...appreciation for music through listening, singing, instruments & movement.

OCP is a Christian Preschool where Christian values will be shared and encouraged.

Completion of a registration form and receipt of a \$50 (\$35/additional child in family) non-refundable registration fee holds your position. (Fees and payments must be by check or cash.)

Additional Programs Available

For families who would like a longer day, children in 3 year old and Pre-K morning classes (potty-trained) may, for an additional monthly fee, choose to extend their day with Lunch Bunch or Extended Day. Select the days your child will attend on the registration form.

Lunch Bunch 11:30-12:30pm

Students bring a packed lunch from home. There is time for socializing with other children and eating lunch.

Extended Day 11:30-3:00pm

Students bring a packed lunch and a snack. Quiet and active group experiences will be planned by qualified teachers. Naps will not be scheduled. A minimum of 8 students is required per day.

Discovery Days

For Pre-K students only, Discovery Days is an enrichment program that follows a theme and offered periodically during the year. (Some programs have included Legos, Undercover Spy, Going Camping, Science, Superheroes.)

Pre-K class eligible for Kindergarten Next Fall


Must be 4 or 5 years old
